


Bureau of Information Technology Project Management Office/Project Management Methodology



The DEP's Project Management Methodology includes five Project Management Process Groups: Project Strategy, Project Initiation, Project Planning/Analysis, Project Execution/Control and Project Closing.

Each of the activities listed within the Process Management Process Groups on this chart has a corresponding electronic template for use.

Activities are not mandatory sequential. It will be at the discretion of the Project Manager which deliverable (s) or tool (s) will be needed or required for each project.

Project Execution/Control 4.0 is an example of a System Development Methodology (SDM). A sub-methodology may be substituted such as software evaluation, policy or training development.
