



Employment Opportunity

The Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) has an immediate opening for Environmental Engineers in Central Office, located in Harrisburg, Pennsylvania. Duties include performing engineering work in the field of environmental engineering for permitting responsibilities related to erosion and sediment control and stormwater permit reviews.

DEP is a state government agency responsible for administering Pennsylvania's environmental laws and regulations related to air, water, waste, mineral resources, radiation, energy, and community revitalization. Many DEP positions are civil service; therefore, applicants **must** participate in civil service examinations to be considered for employment.

Applicants should possess the following:

- Three years of professional experience in environmental engineering, and a bachelor's degree in environmental engineering or in any engineering field that includes or is supplemented by 9 credits in environmental engineering.
- Years of experience or advanced education may be considered qualifying
- **Possession of a valid Professional Engineer license issued by the Pennsylvania State Registration Board for Professional Engineers, Land Surveyors and Geologists is highly desired.**
- Certain positions in this job will require possession of a valid driver's license.

Starting annual salary is \$61,066.

Benefits include: comprehensive health insurance; liberal retirement/pension plan; paid vacation and sick leave; paid holidays; prescription, vision and dental coverage; paid group life insurance; and more.

PA residency is not required.
