The information provided in the application MUST be accurate and complete. Incomplete or inadequate applications will not be considered for funding. Do not submit separate attachments, other than those specifically required by these instructions. The Commonwealth reserves the right to reject any and all applications that do not meet the minimum standards of completeness, as prescribed within these instructions.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

The Onroad Rebate Application must be submitted through the Department of Community and Economic Development's (DCED) Electronic Single Application website, also called eGrants. Paper and faxed copies will not be accepted. The link to the online application can be found at: https://www.esa.dced.state.pa.us/Login.aspx.

User Tips

- 1. Electronic Single Application works best when accessed through Microsoft Edge and Google Chrome.
- 2. If you allow your screen to sit idle for more than 30 minutes, you will lose the data entered since last save and will have to reenter it.
- 3. Save frequently.
- 4. When completing the application, fields with a "•" are required fields. If a required field is skipped, you will be notified later in the application to return to the affected section to complete the field.
- 5. Do not use special characters in the fields such as \setminus , /, *, &, %, #, etc.

CONFIDENTIAL AND PROPRIETARY INFORMATION

The Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) strongly recommends that applicants for funding do not include any confidential or proprietary information. Pursuant to Section 13.2 of the Pennsylvania Air Pollution Control Act, act of January 8, 1960, P.L. 2119 (1959), as amended, 35 P.S. §§ 4001 et seq. ("APCA"), and pursuant to the Pennsylvania Right-to-Know Law, act of February 14, 2008 (P.L. 6, No. 3), 65 P.S. §§ 67.101 et seq. ("RTKL"), records containing confidential business information and personally identifiable information are not public records. However, in exercising the discretion afforded to DEP under 65 P.S. § 67.506(c) of the RTKL, Pennsylvania will make an otherwise exempt record accessible after redaction. If an applicant believes it is absolutely necessary to include confidential or proprietary information, then the applicant must identify with specificity the confidential or proprietary information it seeks to protect, cite the specific statutory support under Pennsylvania's Air Pollution Control Act, Section 13.2, 35 P.S. § 4013.2, for its claim of protection, redact the material that it is claiming is confidential or proprietary information, and submit both a non-redacted and a redacted copy for review. Any confidential or proprietary information submitted directly to DEP through the eGrants system application process (other than uploaded documents) will be appropriately redacted by DEP before public publication.  - a. Question 1 Select Yes or No. Projects must include 5 or fewer vehicles to be eligible.
 - b. Question 2 Select Yes or No. Applicants must be purchasing, not leasing, new vehicles or engines to be eligible.

- e. NAICS Code Use the dropdown menu to select the most appropriate option. You may need to go through several dropdown menus. Once complete, the NAICS code will auto-populate for you.
- f. <u>FEIN/SSN</u> Enter the Federal Employer Identification Number (Federal Tax ID Number) for the organization. If the owner's Social Security Number is used as the FEIN, enter it here. Enter FEIN as 9 digits, no dash.
- g. UEI Number Not required for this rebate application.
- h. <u>Top Official/Signing Authority</u> Enter the name of an authorized representative of the organization, who is the legal signatory for the applicant and has the authority to enter into a contract with the Commonwealth.
- i. <u>Title</u> Enter the title of the person named as the top official/signing authority.
- j. <u>SAP Vendor #</u> Enter the applicant's SAP Vendor Number, if know. This is not required at the time of application but successful applicants that have not had previous contracts or grant agreements with the Commonwealth will be required to obtain a Vendor Identification Number through Vendor Data Management unit, <u>Vendor Registration (pa.gov)</u> (Non-Procurement Vendor Registration Link) and submit a Form W-9, Request for Taxpayer Identification number and certification. An applicant must have an SAP Vendor Number before an award will be made. Applicants may skip this item, but SAP Vendor Registration will be required for successful grantees.
- k. <u>Contact Name</u> Enter the name of the primary contact for the project. This may be an employee or a contractor/consultant. This person will receive all communications from DEP relating to the application (or project, if approved). Ensure that you enter someone here that can act in this capacity.
- 1. <u>Contact Title</u> Enter the title of the primary contact.
- m. Phone and Fax Enter the telephone number (including 4-digit extension, if applicable) and fax number for the primary contact.
- n. <u>Email</u> Enter the email address for the primary contact. Contract documents will be sent and most project correspondence will take place electronically.
- o. Mailing Address, City, State and ZIP Code Enter this information for the primary contact.







- g. <u>Designated areas</u> If the applicant is an Act 47 distressed municipality, select the Act 47 box here. Failure to select this box may result in the applicant only being eligible for the non-Act 47 government reimbursement rate for projects. 




- a. Re-applying Answer "yes" if you are reapplying for a previously awarded project. Add the voucher number to the text box.
- b. <u>Small Business Designation</u> Clicking "Yes" in this section indicates that the applicant organization has 100 or fewer full-time equivalent employees for the entire company, including all employees worldwide for parent companies, subsidiaries, branch offices, and businesses under management in common.
- c. <u>Doing Business As</u> If an applicant is doing business under a name different than the entity's legal name ('Doing Business As, or DBA'), enter applicant's 'Doing Business As' name. Include 'Doing Business As' documentation as an attachment to Question #21 on this tab if applicable.
- d. Organization Type Select the applicant's type of organization from the dropdown menu list of eligible applicants.

- e. <u>Project Duration</u> Identify the current expected project duration. List the start date and estimate the end date using the MM/DD/YYYY format.
- f. Project Type Select the type of project from the dropdown menu.
- g. Current Vehicle/Engine Information
 - 1) Download and complete the Onroad Rebate Vehicle Information Form for all vehicles included in the application.
 - 2) The form requests information including, but not limited to, vehicle type, ownership, registration status, fuel type and fuel use for current and new vehicles.
- h. Operating Predominately in PA Respond yes or no whether all vehicles proposed for replacement or repower are operated predominately in Pennsylvania (PA). Operating predominately in Pennsylvania means that more than 50 percent of a vehicle's annual operating time or more than 50 percent of a vehicle's annual mileage must occur within the boundaries of Pennsylvania.

- i. <u>Physical Location or Base of Operations</u> Indicate whether the applicant has a physical location or base of operations located within the boundaries of Pennsylvania, from which the vehicle proposed for repower or replacement operates.
- j. <u>Drayage Trucks Only</u> Drayage is defined as "a truck pickup from, delivery to, or operation within a seaport, border point, inland port, or intermodal terminal with both the trip origin and destination in the same local area (within 20 miles of the trip origin). Drayage trucks are trucks used for drayage, limited to hauling cargo to and from ports and intermodal rail yards. If the applicant is proposing to replace or repower a drayage truck(s), indicate whether the current and new vehicle(s) meet the program definition of a drayage truck.

k. Electric Vehicle (EV) Infrastructure

- 1) If the applicant is proposing a full electric repower or replacement project, the applicant should indicate if: a) the applicant is applying for funding for EV infrastructure, b) the applicant will fund associated EV infrastructure through a different funding source, or c) the applicant has existing EV infrastructure and no additional EV infrastructure is needed.
- 2) For projects that involve developing infrastructure, state law requires that DEP consider local comprehensive plans and zoning ordinances in funding decisions. If EV infrastructure is proposed, indicate if the proposed project is consistent with county, municipal or multi-municipal comprehensive plans or zoning ordinances for the project location.
- 3) Technical Feasibility Indicate whether the applicant has received confirmation from a vendor or other qualified source that the installation of EV charging infrastructure is technologically feasible at the proposed location. If an applicant indicates yes to this question, and is awarded funding for EV infrastructure, and at some later time during the project period determines that this infrastructure development is not feasible, DEP reserves the right to modify a grant agreement to rescind the funding awarded for EV infrastructure development.
- 1. <u>Priority Areas</u> Identify if the project is located within the priority area. An area may be a priority area under several different designations identified below. Select 'Yes' if one or more of these designations apply and list all that apply in the text box. If none of the designations below apply, select 'No' for this question.
 - 1) Priority based on compliance status with federal air quality measures. Current nonattainment areas for ozone and fine particulate matter are included. This includes the following counties: Allegheny, Armstrong, Beaver, Berks, Bucks, Butler, Carbon, Chester, Delaware, Fayette, Lancaster, Lebanon, Lehigh, Montgomery, Northampton, Philadelphia, Washington, and Westmoreland. Select 'Yes' if the project is in one of these counties and list the county in the text box.
 - 2) Priority based on Environmental Justice (EJ) status. If the location of the project is in an Environmental Justice Area anywhere statewide, it is a priority area. More information on Environmental Justice or designated EJ Areas can be found at the following website: PA Environmental Justice Areas. Select 'Yes' if the project location is in an EJ area and list the EJ area in the text box.

 - 4) <u>Traffic Density</u> If the project locations is in a high traffic density area, select 'Yes' for this question and write 'High Traffic Density Location' in the text box.
 - a) To determine whether the project location(s) is a high traffic density area by using the traffic density map found here. Enter the project address next to the magnifying glass.
 - b) Project Location selected If location is in color 1 (red) or 2 (orange) select yes for high traffic density; any other color, select no for low traffic density.
 - Area of Operation selected Area of operation must be sufficiently detailed in the project summary for reviewers to determine if it is applicable. If the project involves replacement or modification of a source that operates outside of a set location or a local area (i.e. long-haul Class 8 tractor, school buses), the applicant must determine whether the source operates predominately (greater than 50% of operating time) in areas of the traffic map shaded in color 1 (red) or color 2 (orange) (select Yes for high traffic density) or any other color (select No for high traffic density). Zoom in as closely as needed to the project location or area of operation to determine what color the area is shaded.
 - 5) Priority based on high pollution locations. If the project location is one of the following, it is a priority area: ports, rail yards, terminals, distribution centers, truck stops, or school bus depots or yards.  - a) Ports cities, towns, or other places alongside navigable water with facilities for the loading and unloading of cargo from ships; places from which aircraft operate that have paved runways and passenger and cargo terminals which include baggage-movement and passenger-transit operations; and places where foreign goods are inspected by customs officers and allowed to pass into and out of a country.
 - b) Rail yards places at which trains originate or terminate, or at which they are distributed or combined.
 - c) Terminals freight or passenger stations at the end of carrier lines or that serve as junctions at any point with other lines, which have facilities for the handling of freight and passengers.
 - d) Distribution centers facilities that perform consolidation, warehousing, packaging, decomposition and other functions linked with handling freight, often in proximity to major transport routes or terminals, and which generate large amounts of truck traffic.
 - e) Truck stops places especially for truckers that are usually by a highway or interstate that include a parking area, fueling services and/or other facilities.
 - f) Construction sites sites of ongoing large-scale commercial, industrial, or heavy civil construction.

- g) School bus depots/yards parking areas and/or garages where school buses are stored and maintained, or where school buses queue.
- m. Normal Attrition Schedule Provide a detailed description of the applicant organization's normal attrition schedule, operating budget, maintenance and replacement plan or any other organizational plan that determines the replacement schedule for vehicles or equipment.
- n. <u>Self-Certifications</u> These certifications apply to all vehicles proposed for replacement or repower in the application. Check the boxes next to the statement to self-certify that the statements are true for all vehicles.
 - 1) I certify that the vehicle or engine proposed for replacement or repower in this project has have been in the applicant's fleet and used for their intended purposes for at least one (1) year prior to the application date.
 - 2) I certify that:
 - all the Class 4-8 trucks, buses (except transit) or engines proposed for the replacement or repower in this project have at least three years of useful life remaining, in accordance with the attrition schedule described above; or
 - all the transit buses or engines proposed for replacement or repower in this project meet the useful life and project type eligibility requirements detailed in the program guidelines.
- o. Scrapping Vehicle Applicants will be required to scrap or render permanently inoperable the vehicle or engine proposed for replacement or repower in this application. Instructions for scrappage will be included with rebate vouchers but will require, at minimum, scrapping the existing vehicle in a way approved by DEP (such as cutting the frame and drilling a hole in the engine, or crushing/shredding the entire vehicle) and completing a Certificate of Destruction for each vehicle (form provided by DEP), including submitting the required pictures as evidence of scrappage. Failure to provide the required pictures may result in a rebate reimbursement request being rejected. Although it is not required to receive this rebate, DEP suggests applying for a scrappage title for the vehicle from the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation.
- p. Worker Protection and Investment Notice Download the Worker Protection form by clicking the link. Complete the worksheet with your project-specific information including total project costs and selected vehicle type. The worksheet will then automatically calculate the appropriate rebate amount. Once completed, save the document to your computer, and click the "Browse" button to upload the completed worksheet. Once you click "Browse," find the file and select it by doble clicking. The filename will then appear in the "Upload Files" box under Question #17 with the options to View and Delete next to it.
- q. Environmental Justice (EJ) Area
 - 1) Answer "Yes" or "No" if proposed project will be located or implemented in an EJ Area, as defined in the instructions, or will benefit a community located in an EJ area?
 - a) If you answer "Yes" describe the community and how the project will beneficially impact the environmental and/or public health of an underserved community.




