Dated: November 9, 2011


The Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection and BP Products North America Inc. (successor by merger to BP Exploration & Oil Inc.) and Amoco Oil Company (now known as BP Products North America Inc.) ("BP") previously entered into a Cooperative Multi-Site Agreement on or about March 14, 2001. Pursuant to Section V.B.2. of the Cooperative Multi-Site Agreement, including but not limited to subsections a, b, n, o and p, the Oversight Committee, comprised of representatives of BP and the Department, has the authority to add or remove sites to the Cooperative Multi-Site Agreement. As more fully described below, the Oversight Committee agrees to remove two sites as listed in the attached Table 1 to the Site Inventory (Attachment 1 to the Cooperative Multi-Site Agreement). This memorandum of understanding does not constitute a modification of the Cooperative Multi-Site Agreement.

This Memorandum of Understanding is agreed to by the Oversight Committee effective November 9, 2011.




