Throughout the years, the program has sponsored many organizations including Big Brother/Big Sisters, The Humane Society of Harrisburg, Toys for Tots, Central PA Food Bank, Ronald McDonald House, SPCA, Bethesda Mission and Central PA Animal Alliance.

When DEP employees donate money or goods, they are given the opportunity to decorate the tree with a paper 'helping hand'. Each year, a check presentation ceremony is held in the lobby, complete with Christmas carols sung by DEP's own chorale group, the Earth Tones.
