Well over a century ago, the site now known as the Pullman Center Business Park in the city of Butler, Butler County, was home to fessional offices and retail industrial and manufacturing uses, including food pro-Nixsar Group, Pyramid duction and a brickvard. Forty-six acres remain to be continue for the Pullman Center Business Park expansion.
