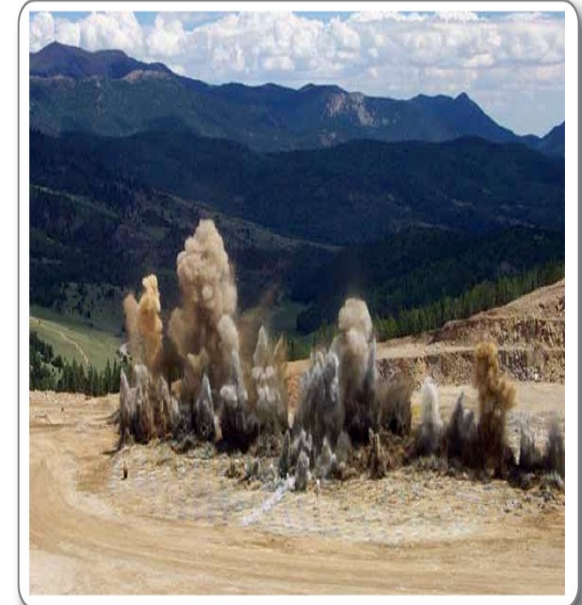

The topics will include blasting safety, accident prevention, blasting calculations, regulatory issues, and the effect of geology. This information is intended to help a blaster be successful on the job by working safely and efficiently.

Blasters in states other than Pennsylvania should contact their regulatory agencies to determine if this class would qualify for their required training.
