- O&G will be the 5th DEP program to release applications on the ePermitting platform
 - Mining
 - Storage Tanks
 - Radiation Protection
 - Air Quality
- O&G applications for well permits and ESGP3 are currently under development
- Program will begin user acceptance testing the last week of August



Testing

- External users will be able to test the application on two dates
 - September 11, 2018: ESGP3 application
 - September 12, 2018: Well Permitting application
 - Users will need to come to a DEP office to conduct testing
 - Rachel Carson State Office Building, Harrisburg, PA
 - Other locations to be determined
 - Participation is limited and will be on a first come basis

Training

- Training for external users will be conducted via webinar
 - September 18, 2018, 1:00 PM-2:30 PM: Well Permitting application
 - September 19, 2018, 1:00 PM-2:30 PM: ESGP3 application
 - Additional information regarding those webinars will be provided via email
 - Additional training sessions are being planned



Go Live

- ePermitting application go live date is September 20, 2018, for both well and ESGP3 permitting
 - Unconventional well permit applications are required by regulation to be submitted to the DEP electronically
 - Conventional well permit applications (excluding CBM, injection/disposal, and gas storage wells) and ESGP3 may be submitted electronically



Current eWell Application

- As of 4:00 PM on September 19, 2018, users will no longer be able to submit well permit applications via the current eWell application
- Any pending well permit applications submitted prior to that time will continue to be managed within the eWell application until disposition
