<u>Tod Schench</u> – Holds a water certificate in Maryland that expires 7/1/15. He has 5 years, 9 months working at Darlington WTP, Campus Hills WTP and Muddy Run WTP which are class D systems using subclasses 7,8,12 and distribution.

The Department recommendation is to issue a WDE 7,8,12

WASTEWATER

<u>Tod Schench</u> – Holds a temporary (OIT) wastewater certificate in Maryland that expires 7/1/15. He has 5 years, 9 months working at Conowingo WWTP, Elk Neck State Park WWTP and Muddy Run WWTP which are class D systems using subclass 1 and 4 collections.

The Department recommendation is to deny since he is not yet a regular operator.
