BCR Mission

- Restore polluted streams and lakes so that they can be removed from the impaired waters list.
 - aka "Get dirty waters off the dirty waters list"



- BCR Action Plan Priorities
 - Manage multiple funding streams to maximize the restoration of impaired waters
 - Finalize set-aside guidelines and develop a list of priority watersheds and projects for restoration and implementation



- BCR Action Plan Priorities (continued)
 - Identify and complete maintenance, repairs and upgrades to existing BCR treatment facilities in high priority watersheds
 - Finalize and Issue CAFO PAG-12



- BCR Action Plan Priorities (continued)
 - Increase efforts to achieve Agriculture sector
 compliance with regulatory requirements
 - Develop and implement a process to report
 significant improvement to streams and lakes and
 to inform the public of those successes



- Funding Programs
 - Watershed Stewardship Grants (Growing Greener)
 - Section 319 Nonpoint Source Management
 - AMD Set-aside
 - Chesapeake Bay Funding to CDs



- Funding Programs (continued)
 - Watershed Stewardship Grants (Growing Greener)
 - Focus on funding in priority watersheds
 - Include an AMD set-aside project solicitation in the GG program
 - Re-open GG program to general AMD projects



- Funding Programs (continued)
 - Section 319 Nonpoint Source Management
 - Focus funding in priority watersheds



- Funding Programs (continued)
 - AMD Set-aside
 - Focus use of money in priority watersheds where remediation efforts will significantly improve or restore stream segments or designated uses

 - Chesapeake Bay funding to CDs
 - Target resources to implement the Chesapeake Bay WIP











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
