#### **Environmental Education Fund**

- Environmental Education Act of 1993
- Five percent of fines and penalties collected from...
  - Clean Water fund
  - Clean Air fund
  - Solid Waste Abatement fund
  - Well Plugging fund
  - Other funds
- Awarded more than \$9 million; 1,600 projects
- Averaging \$300,000 per year in awards

- Advisory Council on Environmental Education








### 2015 EE Grant Round

- Application Process
  - Due date December 19<sup>th</sup>
  - Summary proposal emails
- Maximum Request \$3,000
  - One year projects
  - No match requirement
  - Broader scope projects can apply for second year of funding
- **Timeline** Activity begins July 1, 2015, ends June 30, 2016; no time extensions
- Final Report










### 2015 EE Grant Timeline

- Grant round opens—Oct. 6<sup>th</sup>
- Proposal email—Nov. 7<sup>th</sup>
- Due date—Dec. 19<sup>th</sup>
- Grant review
  - 75 raters approx.
- Award announcement around Earth Day
- Start date—July 1, 2015
- Completion date—June 30, 2016
- Final report due—July 15, 2016







#### 1. Curriculum Integration

- Applicants: school districts;
- private and charter schools
- Audience: teachers (K–12)
- Purpose: articulate the EE standards into K-12 curriculum

#### 2. Curriculum Revision

- Applicants: same
- Audience: same
- Purpose: revise or write lessons plans/units; provide classroom assessment







- 3. Keystone Energy Education Program
- Applicants: school districts;
   private and charter schools
- Audience: teachers, students, building managers, administration
- Purpose: reduce school building's energy use with student energy team







- 4. Outdoor Learning Resource Projects
- Applicants: school districts;
- private and charter schools
- Audience: teachers and students
- Purpose: develop trails, energy or agriculture demonstration projects, ponds and other outdoor areas integrated into curriculum for experiential learning







- 5. Field Trips and Hands-on Activity Supplies
- Applicants: public, private and charter schools
- Audience: students
- Purpose: provide educational resources, materials, equipment, transportation, entrance fees for hands-on activities







#### 6. Other EE Projects

- Applicants: county conservation districts, nonprofits, municipalities, businesses, colleges/universities
- Audience: Any target audience
- Purpose: environmental education on specific topic


