

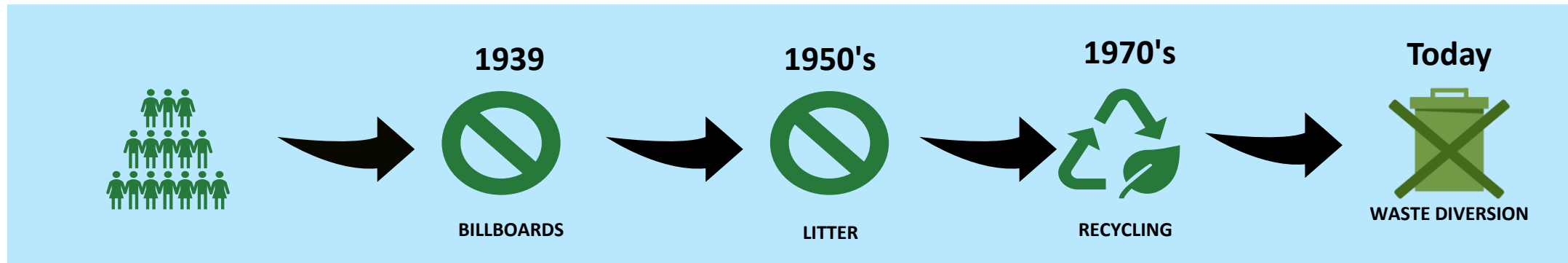

Electronics Recycling in PA

Scale of Problem

- E-waste generation
- Illegal Dumping
- Access to facilities

Solutions

- CDRA
- HB 1607 (& SB 734)

Scale of the Problem

Statewide disposal numbers:

- Electronics (covered devices): 11,640 tons
- Other Electronics: 42,728 tons

Access to free sites

- 21 Counties in PA have 2 or less CDRA collection sites



Issues with CDRA

- Weight based recycling obligations
- Only 85% of population is required to be able to access recycling – while 100% of population must obey landfill ban
- Unrestricted access only available to less than 25% of population

Eco-Deposits: Maximum Amounts?
