KSL's Response to DEP's October 30, 2023 letter regarding Recent Odor Complaints
Dunmore and Throop Boroughs, Lackawanna County

Dear Mr. O'Brien:

The Department of Environmental Protection ("DEP") has received and reviewed KSL's response to DEP's October 30, 2023 "Recent Odor Complaints" letter. After evaluating this response, DEP has determined that KSL has not provided all of the information requested. Specifically, DEP requested:

- A narrative detailing the evaluation conducted on the data to show whether the results triggered KSL to initiate emission reduction efforts.
- If the evaluation triggered emission reduction efforts, provide a narrative of all of the efforts conducted for each area that triggered the emission reduction efforts.

KSL's response included general protocols typically utilized to evaluate the data obtained through the monthly enhanced surface monitoring and general mitigation measures KSL utilizes to address areas of concern. These generalized narratives do not adequately fulfill DEP's request.

Therefore, please provide the following information within 5 days of receipt of this letter, so that DEP can determine if KSL has complied with its Nuisance Minimization and Control Plan:

- KSL should provide specific information relative to each monthly enhanced surface monitoring scan. The information should include a narrative detailing how KSL identified any areas of concern. If areas of concern were identified, KSL should provide a narrative describing any mitigation measures implemented to address these areas as well as any follow-up monitoring that may have been conducted to determine if mitigation measures were effective.
