The District and the DEP have completed the review of the subject application and have identified a technical deficiency that may be able to be addressed informally. The deficiency is as follows:

- 1. The purpose of the haul road is transport spoil material from the excavated area. Clarify where the spoil material is being deposited. If the desposit site is adjacent to or within ¼ mile of the excavation site and is not current covered under a Chapter 102 NPDES permit or approved E&S plan, which ever is applicable, the deposit site shall be incorporated into this permit. If the site is to be incorporated into the current permit, provide the following:
 - a. Revised drawings to show the spoil area site with proposed contours
 - b. Appropriate E&S BMPs with calculations
 - c. Revise all application forms to incorporate the additional earth disturbance area
 - d. Provide the additional disturbed acreage fee.

The DEP notes that if the spoil site is not currently covered by a Chapter 102 NPDES permit or approved E&S plan, whichever is applicable, then earth disturbances are not to occur on the site until coverage is approved. Any earth disturbance currently occuring should cease and the site should be temporarily stabilized.

Unless the District prefers an alternate method, provide 2 hard copies of any revised or additional documents to the District by 4 pm, August 9, 2023 or the DEP will send the formal Technical Deficiency Letter. Also upload an electronic copy of any revised or additional documents to the DEP's OnBase system
