The Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) has reviewed your response to the our second environmental assessment review letter and has the following comments:

1. Attachment 6 – ARM Group Responses to PADEP 2<sup>nd</sup> EA Letter: Page 9, Comment 10b, Last Paragraph, First Sentence should indicate north instead of south as highlighted below:


*“Soil Test Boring MSEB-12 is located approximately 700 feet **north** of the aforementioned location.....”*

2. Attachment 6.2 – Shear Wave Velocity data from 2010: Tabulated data was incorporated in the response; however, the entire 2010 *Shear Wave Velocity Report* and a site map showing the ground surface points along the survey line were not included. It is recommended that LCSWMA submit the report and attachments (i.e. tables, figures, etc.).
3. On page 3 of your Transportation Compliance Plan, penalties are outlined for varying degrees of overweight vehicles. Are there set penalties for repeat offenders?
4. School bus stops are noted on the maps for areas that we requested in the first EAP letter. However, how are trash truck drivers made aware of school bus stop locations and bus routes on the remainder of the haul routes?

If you believe that any of the stated deficiencies is not significant, instead of submitting a response to that deficiency, you have the option of asking DEP to make a decision based on the information with regard to the subject matter of that deficiency that you have already made available. If you choose this option with regard to any deficiency, you should explain and justify how your current submission satisfies that deficiency. Please keep in mind that if you fail to respond, your application may be denied.
