30, 2015 New Hope Crushed Stone & Lime Co. (New Hope) submitted a Reclamation Plan ("Plan") to reclaim the SMP. The													
Department reviewed the Plan and determined it was unacceptable because the proposed reclamation plan/timetable did not													
abate the public nuisance noted in the Environmental Hearing Board ("EHB") Adjudication dated July 31, 2014, in a timely													
manner. In a letter dated January 29, 2016, the Department notified New Hope that it could not approve the Plan as submitted													
and modified it to abate the nuisance declared by the EHB in a timely manner. New Hope was to complete the reclamation													
activities outlined in the Department's January 29, 2016 letter by March 2019. New Hope has failed to complete the													
reclamation activities outlined in the Department's January 29, 2016 letter by March 2019.

Therefore, Compliance Order No. 19-5-015-N is issued. New Hope shall immediately cease active mining operations and conduct reclamation to address the reclamation shortfall by the following reclamation schedule/timeline: 1) No mining activity is authorized until such time as the reclamation work outlined in this schedule is completed and approved by the Department; 2) New Hope shall perform original stream channel elevation and location investigation by April 26, 2019. This should also include the natural ground elevation along the quarry rim 25 feet on each side (North & South) of the original stream channel once excavated; 3) Complete backfilling of staked areas 3 through 20, referenced on the Reclamation Update Map dated August 4, 2016 ("RUM") by May 15, 2019; 4) Seed/plant all backfilled slopes in staked areas 3 through 20, referenced on the RUM (except for the inlet area) by May 30, 2019; 5) Begin maximum pumping rate of 500,000 gallons per day on June 5, 2019; 6) Complete stream restoration work (not including inlet) by June 15, 2019; 7) Complete backfilling and planting of staked areas 1 through 3 and staked areas 20 through and south of 23, referenced on the RUM (all uncompleted areas) by September 15, 2019; 8) Submit monthly reclamation progress reports by the 5th of the month for the preceding month; 9) Submit two survey or other engineered (measurement/calculation) reports verifying the amount of reclamation fill material placed. The first survey report is due by June 15, 2019 and the second survey report is due by September 27, 2019.

Pursuant to §§ 5, 301, 307, 315, 316, 401, 402, 601, and 610 of the Clean Streams Law (35 P.S. §§ 691.5, 691,301, 691.307, 691.315, 691.316, 691.401 691.402, 691.601, and 691.610), §§ 4.2 and 4.3 of the Surface Mining Conservation and Reclamation Act (52 P.S. §§ 1396.4b and 1396.4c), § 11 of the Noncoal Surface Mining Conservation and Reclamation Act, (52 P.S. § 3311), §§ 3.1 and 9 of the Coal Refuse Disposal Control Act, (P.L. 31, 52 P.S. § 1406.1), §§ 701-101 et seq., of the Bituminous Coal Mine Act (52 P.S. §§ 701-101) and Section 1917-A of the Administrative Code (71 P.S. § 510-17), and 25 Pa.
