I checked with our Northwest Regional Office and received information from our Bureau of Clean Water that the Greentree Landfill wastewater treatment facility has been having difficulty meeting their NPDES permit limits. Greentree Landfill will have to demonstrate that they can handle the additional load on the treatment plant and still meet their permit limits before we can give approval for Sanitary Landfill to transport their leachate there.

Please contact Justin Dickey, Program Manager for the Clean Water Program in the PA DEP Northwest Regional Office to discuss this further. 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Good Afternoon Sharon,

This email is to request written approval from the Department based on our Leachate Consent order and Agreement Page 7 paragraph 5 which states, "In the event that Sanitary Landfill intends to modify its current landfill leachate transportation practices...it shall submit notification of such plans, including the details of any modifications, to the Department at least five (5) days prior to any modification taking place. Sanitary Landfill shall not dispose of landfill leachate at any location in the Commonwealth not specifically listed in Paragraph J without prior written approval from the Department."

We intend to start sending leachate from Westmoreland Sanitary Landfill to the wastewater treatment facility located in Kersey, PA owned and operated by Greentree Landfill. This facility

is located on landfill grounds and is permitted to accept and treat wastewater from external sources. Both facilities are owned by Noble Environmental, in which Mr. Walton is the owner. We plan to begin sending leachate to this site as soon as written approval is given. If any more information is required by the department, please let me know.

Thanks for the call. We will get you and update on Greentree and the upgrades we have planned.

On a separate topic, Southwest DEP has requested that we receive confirmation from the Northwest DEP office that we can take Westmoreland Sanitary Landfill Leachate beginning later this week. As we discussed this morning we have months of available storage and the plant is able to take more leachate that we currently have available to send to the plant. In addition Westmoreland leachate is lower strength than Greentree leachate but we would make sure to start slow and buildup provided it meets all of our permit conditions and requirements.
