This letter serves as notification that the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection will undertake an investigation at the above referenced Site.

Pursuant to Section 501(e) of the Hazardous Sites Cleanup Act, Act of October 18, 1988 (P.L. 756, No. 108), 35 P.S. Section 6020.501(e), the Department is required to provide notice of this action to the owner or operator of the property on which the Site is located.

The Department has determined that you may be the owner of property that makes up a portion of the Keystone Metals Reduction Site, located on a portion of the 1000 block of Pittsburgh Street in Cheswick Borough. The Department's action at this site will involve an investigation to determine if radioactive materials from the production of radium have been disposed at the location of the former Keystone Metals Reduction Facility.

This letter is not a final action by the Department, nor is any action being requested of you by this letter.
