The Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (Department), under the authority of the Hazardous Sites Cleanup Act, 35 P.S.
Section 6020, 101 et. Seq. (HSCA), has proposed an interim response at the keystone Metals Reduction Site (Sile). The Site is located in the 1000 block of Freeport Road in the Borough of Cheswick, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania on property that is now owned by North American County, Pennsylvania on property that is now owned by North American and determined that Radium-226 is the primary Contaminant of Concern on the property.
