This is to inform you that the Department of Environmental Protection (Department) has determined that the Pool Doctor / Beaver Alkali Site located at 25 New York Ave, Rochester, Pennsylvania poses a threat to human health and the environment due to many containers of abandoned chemicals being stored at the site.

Furthermore, the Department has determined that a Prompt Interim Response, under the authority of Section 501(a) of the Pennsylvania Hazardous Sites Cleanup Act (HSCA), Act of October 18, 1988 (P.L. 756, No. 108), 35 P.S. Section 6020.501(a), is appropriate based on the dilapidated condition of the buildings where these chemicals are being stored.
