This letter serves as notification that the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (Department) has concluded its prompt interim response under the Hazardous Sites Cleanup Act (HSCA) for the Pool Doctor-Beaver Alkali Products Site in Rochester Borough, Beaver County (Site). All hazardous chemicals that were identified by the Department as improperly stored or disposed of at the Site have been removed and processed accordingly. The Department and their contractors have exited the Site and removed any access barriers installed during their response actions.

At this time, the Department yields jurisdiction to the local authority. Rochester Borough may now conduct any necessary building code inspections for public health and safety as they relate to the stability and occupancy of any structures at this Site. In addition, occupancy may have changed as a result of the Department's response and the business owner(s) may need to update their information with your zoning office.
