## **NOTICE OF VIOLATION**

Re: INDUSTRIAL WASTE Monaca Plant NPDES Permit No. PA0002208 Potter Township, Beaver County

Dear Ms. Kaal:

The Department of Environmental Protection (Department) finds, as a result of a review of your Incident Report(s) relating to visible foam discharged from your facility at outfall 001 which was self-reported initially on July 21, 2022, and a complaint received by the Department regarding a discharge of foam on July 26 as the unauthorized discharge of INDUSTRIAL WASTE.

Such condition(s) IS/ARE in violation of your permit No. P0002208. Consequently, you are in violation of the Pennsylvania Clean Streams Law, the Act of June 22, 1937, P.L. 1987, <u>as amended</u>, and subject to the penalties provided therein.

We have already received a written response regarding this pollution incident.

If there is anything additional to add to this response, we request that you submit a report to this office within 15 working days of the date of this letter. Any additional response should further describe the cause of noncompliance and the steps being taken to prevent recurrence of the violation, along with a correction schedule.

This Notice of Violation is neither an order nor any other final action of the Department of Environmental Protection. It neither imposes nor waives any enforcement action available to the Department under any of its statutes. If the Department determines that an enforcement action is appropriate, you will be notified of the action.
