An operator needs at least one subclass in a treatment technology to receive certification. <u>(See</u> <u>Certification Classes and Subclasses</u>).

If an applicant chooses to use the Track 2 (college degree) option, they cannot use DEP-approved training to reduce their experience requirements. Track 2 applicants must use their advanced degrees and certifications to offset or reduce their experience requirement.

The graphic below helps you determine which track applies to you. It is important to remember you can only choose one track option. You cannot mix and match requirements. An applicant for operator certification using Track 1 (HS Diploma or GED) experience requirements, may also use outside training to receive up to 50 percent of their experience requirement. This type of training is approved DEP training that is not part of a college or certificate program.

Note: Multiple DEP Approved training certificates, an accredited Certificate Program certificate(s) or already having a license in the opposite field (water or wastewater) may be used to substitute up to 50% of the total experience required. Successful completion of 10 hours of DEP-approved water or wastewater training is equivalent to 1 month of operating experience. 1 college credit equals 1.5 months of experience.
