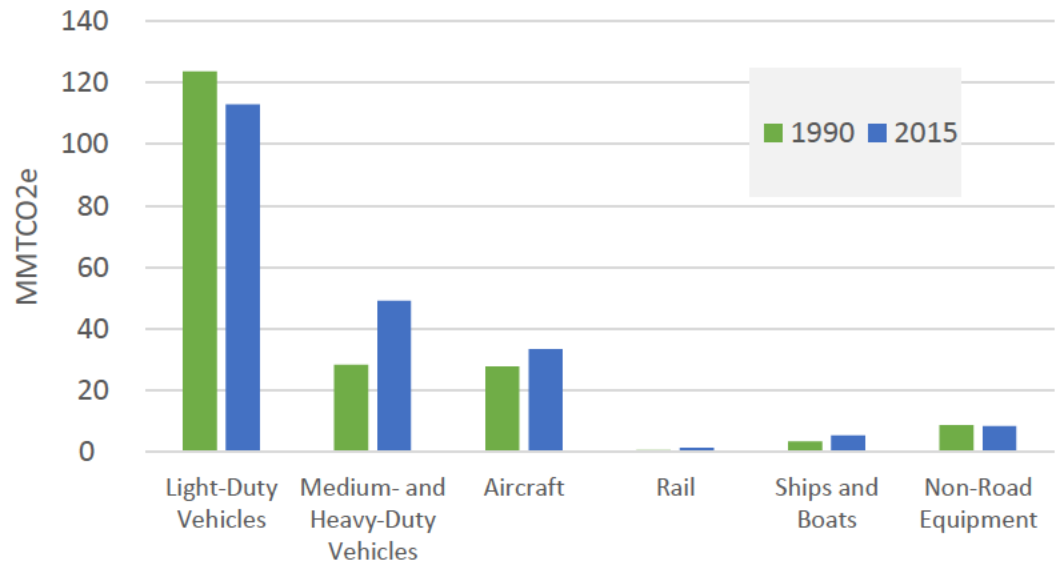
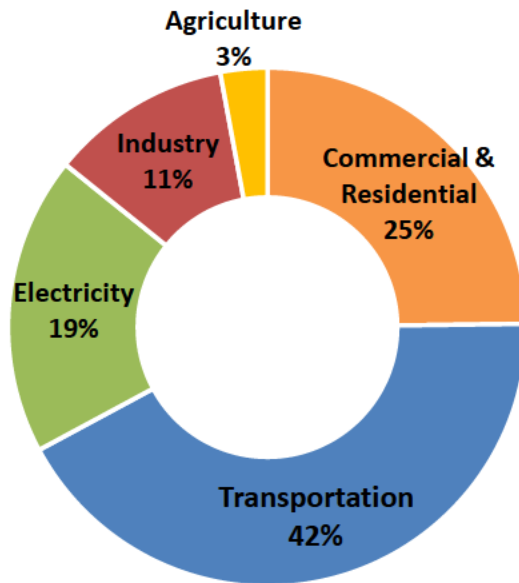

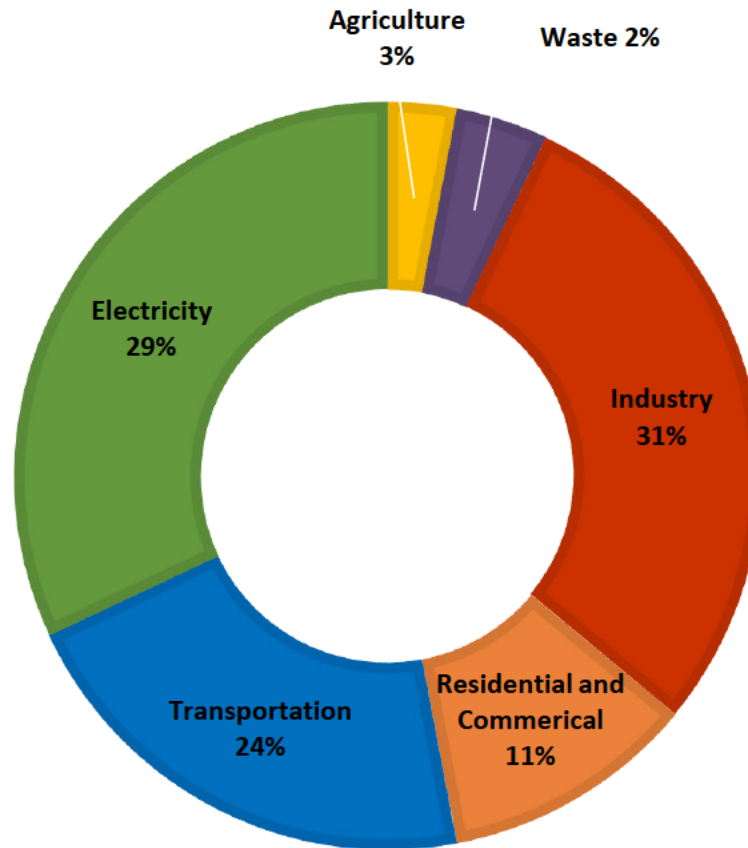

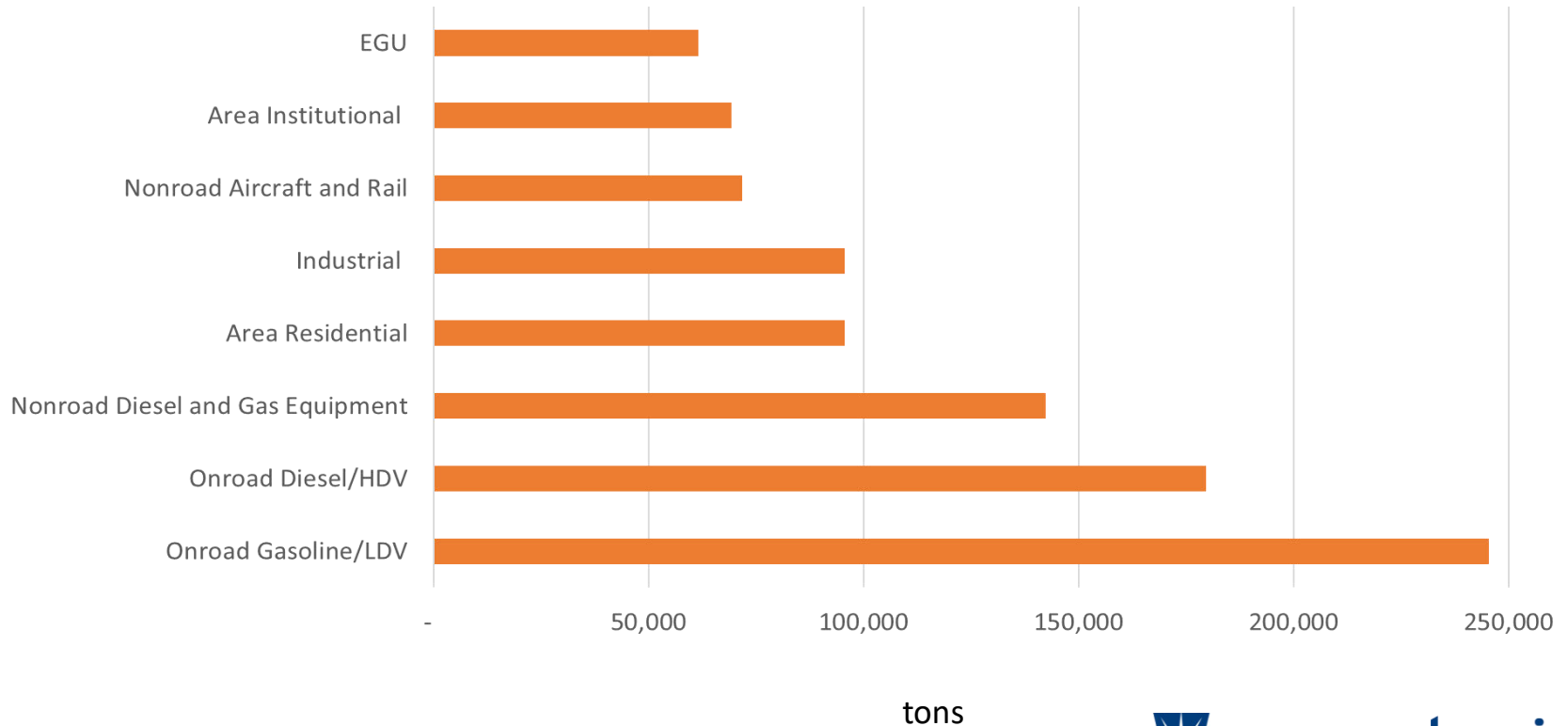
Greenhouse Gas Emissions in Pennsylvania

2017 NOx Emissions in Mid-Atlantic/Northeast



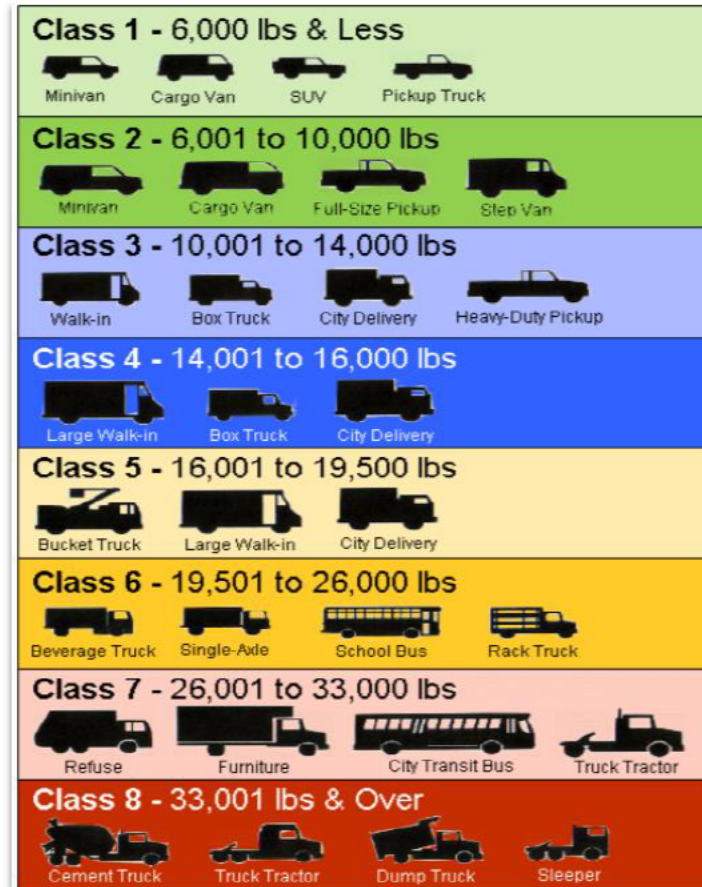
MOU Concepts

- Commits signatories to work together to foster a self-sustaining market for zero emission medium- and heavy-duty duty (MHD) vehicles.
- Call for 30% of new truck and bus sales to be zero-emission by 2030 and 100% by 2050
- Emphasizes need to accelerate deployment of zero-emission trucks and buses in disadvantaged communities.
- Directs development and implementation of MHD ZEV Action Plan.

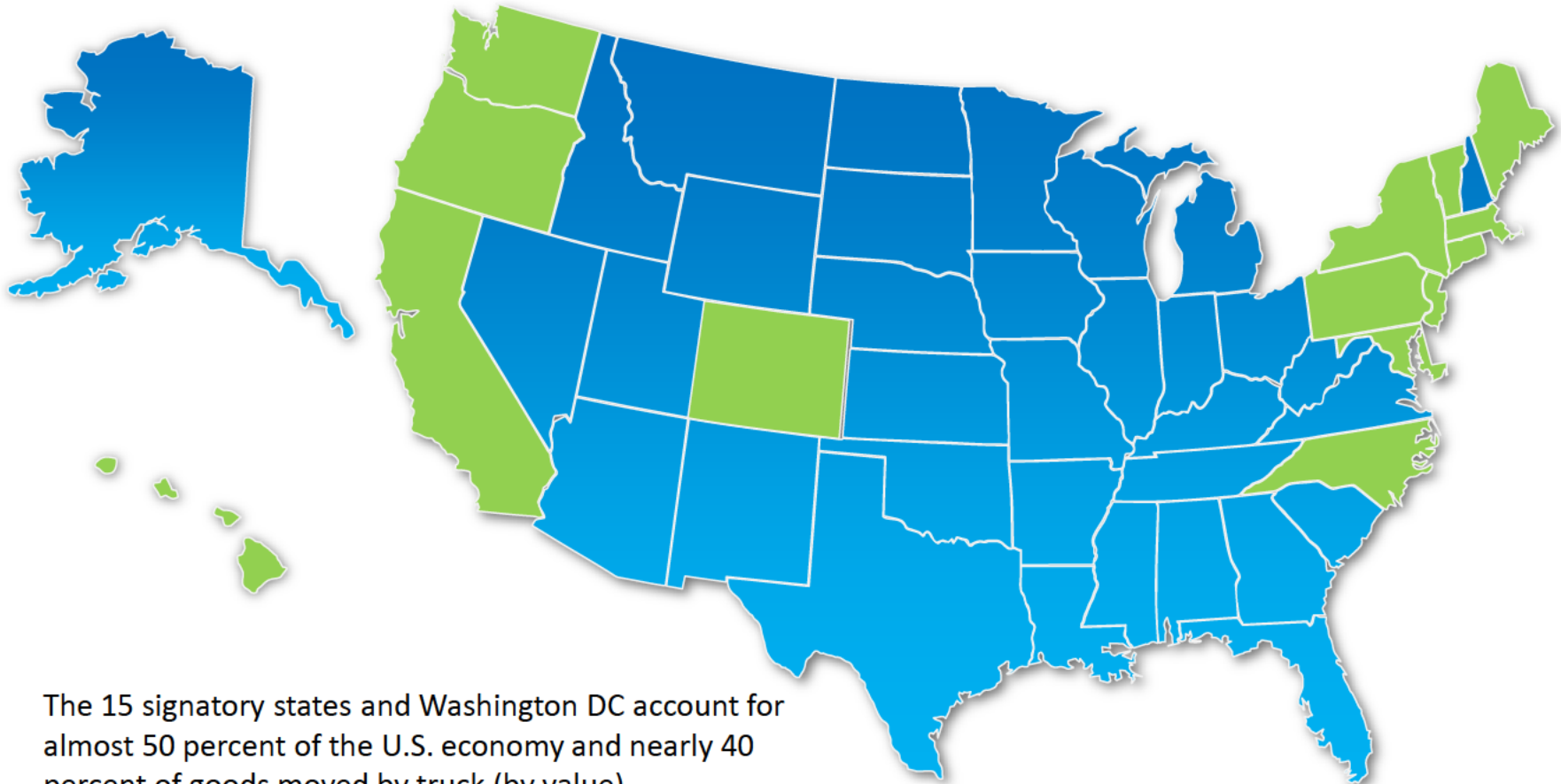
Affected Vehicles

Truck Classifications

- Vehicle classes are based on gross vehicle weight rating (GVWR)
- Class 2 is subdivided into:
 - Class 2a with a GVWR of 6,001-8,500 lb; and
 - Class 2b vehicles with a GVWR of 8,501-10,000 lb.
- MHDVs consist of classes 2b-8.



MHD ZEV MOU Signatories



The 15 signatory states and Washington DC account for almost 50 percent of the U.S. economy and nearly 40 percent of goods moved by truck (by value).

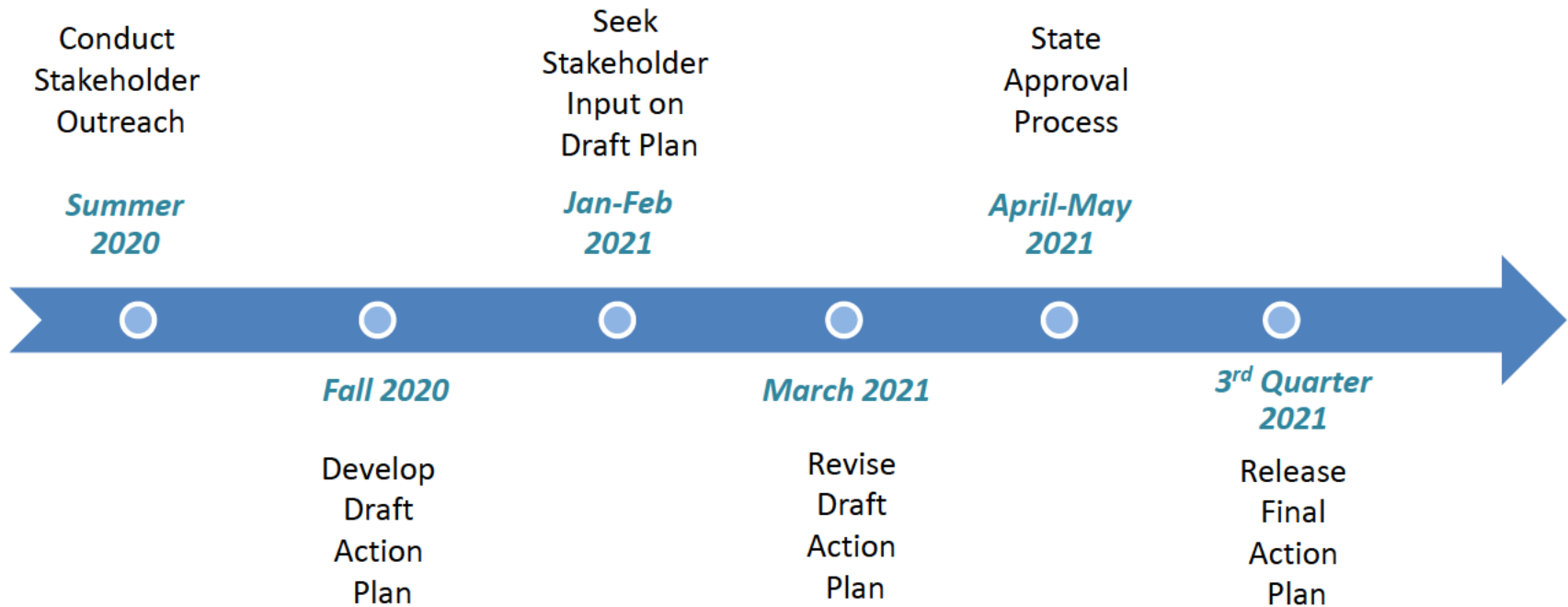
