New Potential PM2.5 NAAQS Revision – Hallie Weiss, DEP's Air Quality Program Specialist in the Quality Assurance & Data Assessment Section, Air Quality Monitoring Division, will discuss the new potential National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS) for fine particulate matter (PM2.5). Signature and publication of the final rule in late 2023/early 2024 suggests the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) favors a primary annual standard of 9.0 μ g/m3 from 12.0 μ g/m3 and a primary unchanged 24-hour standard of 35 μ g/m3.
