Draft Proposed Rulemaking: Delegation of Authority of Federal Plans – Soumya Arikeri and Sean Wenrich, of DEP's Bureau of Air Quality New Source Review Section will discuss DEP's proposal to amend 25 Pa. Code Chapter 122 to provide legal authority for the Department to either: adopt and submit to the EPA for approval a State Plan developed in accordance with 40 CFR Part 60, Subparts B and Ba, or request delegation from the EPA to implement and enforce the requirements of an applicable Federal Plan established by the EPA. 2023 PM2.5 Year in Review/PM2.5 NAAQS – A presentation of the new fine particulate matter (PM2.5) National Ambient Air Quality Standard (NAAQS) will be given by DEP Air Quality Program Specialists Bryan Oshinski and Hallie Weiss. This presentation will discuss the revision of the primary annual standard to 9.0 µg/m³, the designation and implementation processes, and air monitoring impacts.
