
Dear Mr. Welsh:

Enclosed is the revised Section 111(d) State Plan for designated Coal-Fired Electric Steam  
Generating Units (EGUs). This State Plan was revised in order to include the official version of the  
mercury final rulemaking, 25 Pa Code Chapter 123, §§ 123.201-123.215, that was published on  
February 17, 2007 in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* (37 Pa.B. 907). This mercury final regulation was  
effective as of the date of publication.

I have enclosed five copies of the revised Section 111(d) State Plan for your approval to implement  
and enforce Pennsylvania's State Plan to reduce mercury emissions from affected coal-fired EGUs.

We would like to thank your Air Program staff for the comprehensive review of both the proposed
