*There are over 1.3 million underground tanks in the U.S. that contain petroleum. It has been estimated that thousands of these tanks are currently leaking, with many more expected to leak as they reach the end of their tank life within the next ten years. In October 1986, Congress amended Subtitle I of the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act to provide a Federal Trust Fund to finance the cleanup of petroleum releases from underground storage tanks. The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) intends to make available Trust Fund monies through cooperative agreements with States having acceptable plans for using fund resources. The cooperative agreement is an assistance instrument which establishes the respective responsibilities of an individual state for implementation, and EPA for both oversight and technical assistance under the Trust Fund corrective action program. High priority for corrective actions is to be given to (1) releases which pose the greatest threat to human health and the environment, and (2) sites where the state cannot identify a solvent owner or operator of the tank who will undertake action properly.*
