Commercial ag producers who conduct normal farming operations in Pennsylvania are eligible to apply

Rebates are being offered for:

- LED lighting (including fixtures and controls)
- Efficient milk pumping equipment (including pumps, motors, and controls such as variable frequency drives)
- Efficient ventilation equipment (including fans, motors, and controls such as variable frequency drives)

Applications are being accepted on a first-come, first-served basis as funding remains available or through June 30, 2022
