### Goals and process

- 1) End goal—an adaptation plan that includes:
  - a. summary of initially defined vulnerabilities and risks with a process to permit/encourage a dynamic list
  - b. Identification of strategies to address vulnerabilities and risks that includes practical strategies and/or a data/research needs list
  - c. Prioritize list of strategies
  - d. Recommend both short term and long term plan to adapt beyond immediate priorities
  
- 2) Process
  - a. vulnerabilities
  - b. risks
  - c. implementation strategies and data gaps
  - d. prioritization (short term) and long term plan
  
- 3) Meeting goals
  - a. *May 21 meeting*: Brainstorm session to ID vulnerabilities and risks
  - b. *July 27 meeting*: Review work of May meeting and draft matrix; identify practical adaptation strategies and data currently available and data gaps to address each defined risk area
  - c. *September 29 meeting*: review work of July meeting, prioritize adaptation strategies
  - d. *October 26 meeting*: draft report presented to work group; discuss edits/revisions
  - e. **Revised deadline - November 22**: report submitted to DEP and Climate Change Advisory Committee. Final report to be released in January 2011.
