**EXECUTIVE SESSION<sup>1</sup>**

The Board moved into Executive Session at 2:01 p.m. to discuss matters involving potential litigation pursuant to the Sunshine Act (65 Pa.C.S. § 708(a)(4), (5)). The Board concluded the Executive Session at 2:27 p.m.

**CALL TO ORDER AND ATTENDANCE**

The meeting was called to order by Chair Jessica Shirley, Secretary of DEP, at 2:32 p.m. Chair Shirley stated for the record that, immediately prior to the public meeting, the PEDA board held an executive session under Section 708(a)(4) and (5) of the Sunshine Act to discuss matters involving potential litigation and that no official action was taken during the executive session. David Althoff conducted the roll call. A quorum was established.

**APPROVAL OF PREVIOUS MEETING MINUTES (ACTION)**

Chair Shirley requested consideration of the May 20, 2025, meeting minutes.

**Motion:** Romy Diaz moved to adopt the minutes from the May 20, 2025, with Wendy Spicher seconding the motion. There was no discussion on the motion. Because all of the board members were participating via Teams, Chair Shirley called for a roll call vote on the motion, which passed unanimously.

**FINANCIAL UPDATE**

Assistant Treasurer Alayna Schmeider provided an update on PEDA's financial status.

**NEW BUSINESS (ACTION)**

Chair Shirley asked the Board to consider the following motion:

*The PEDA board authorizes the chair to take any legal action on behalf of PEDA deemed necessary to challenge the EPA's purported termination of PEDA's Solar for All award, pursue the reinstatement of the award, seek damages and other relief, and/or protect PEDA's interests in the funds. The chair is further authorized to enter into an agreement, if necessary, for the Governor's Office of General Counsel or the Department of Environmental Protection's Office of Chief Counsel to represent PEDA in any legal action related to the purported termination of the Solar for All award.*

**Motion:** Elizabeth Fielder moved, with Romy Diaz seconding the motion.

Glendon King stated his view that the board did not have enough time or information to consider the motion other than during the Executive Session, such broad authority should not be granted as a general matter, PEDA may not have been structured to manage programs as large as Solar for All, and the legislature has not yet authorized expenditures under the program. He asked board members to oppose the motion. There was no further discussion.

Because all board members were participating via Teams, Chair Shirley called for a roll call vote on the motion.

The motion passed with 9 votes in favor, 2 against, and 2 abstentions. Glendon King and Matt Osenbach voted nay. Melanie El Atieh and Bernie Lynch abstained.

No comments were made.
