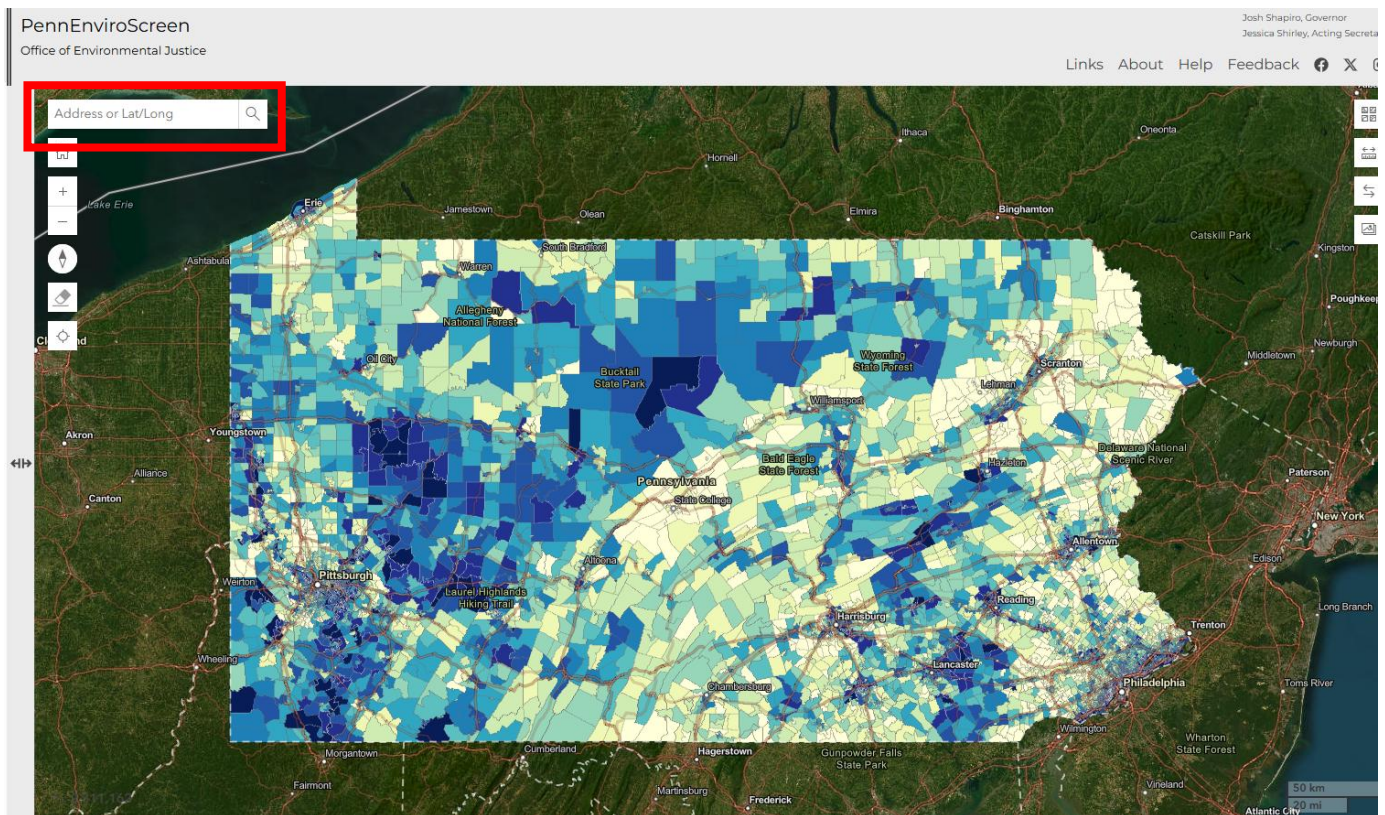


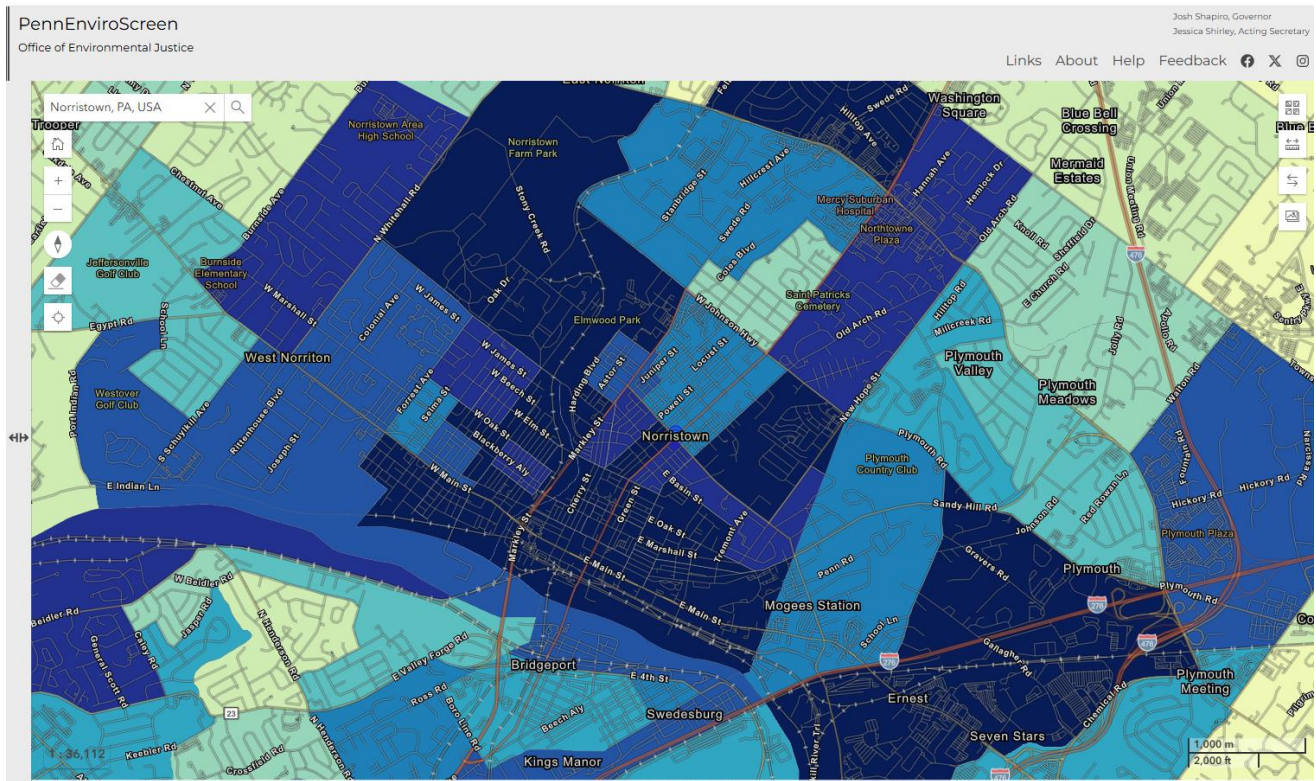
Community Benefits Bonus: Updated Mapping Tool Instructions

RISE PA Applicants pursuing the Community Benefits Bonus should follow these steps to identify the low-income disadvantaged communities that will receive the community benefits laid out in their Community Benefits Plans.

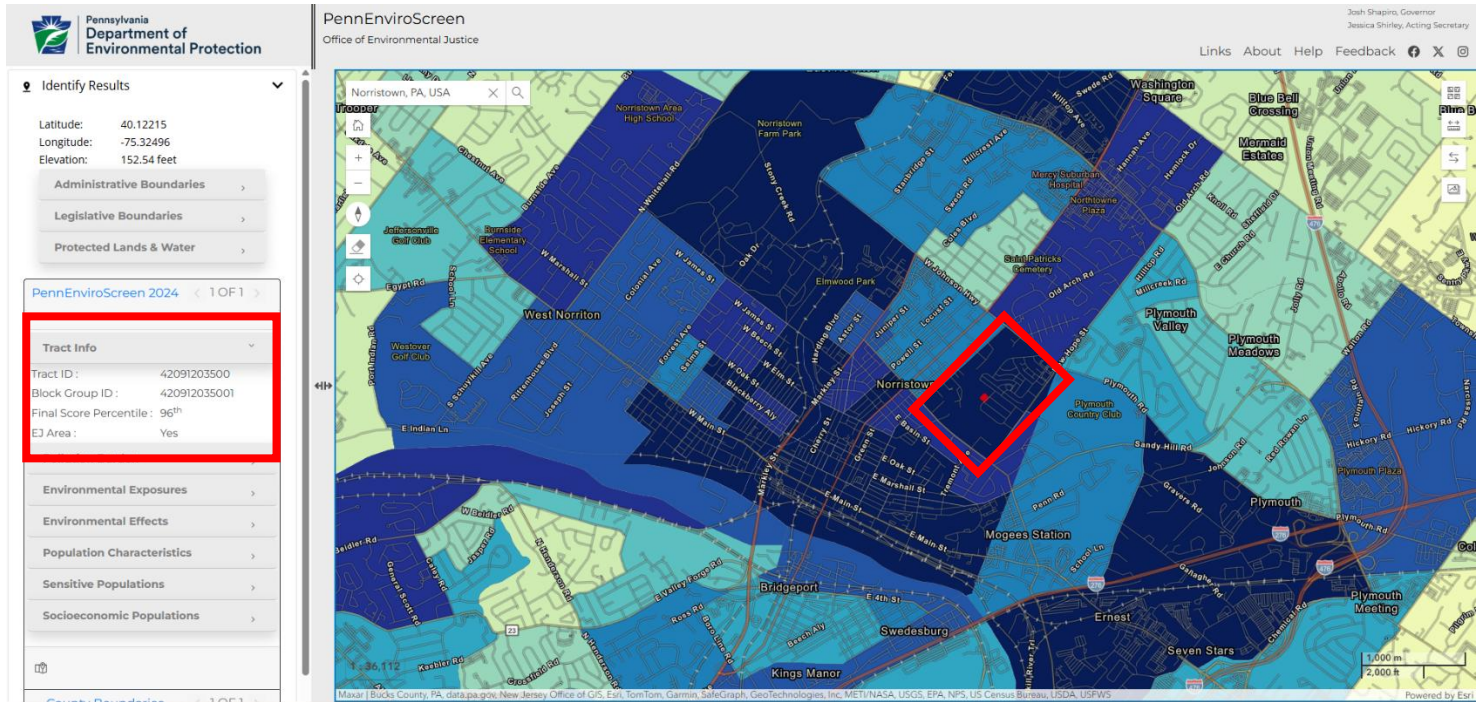
1. Click the link to access DEP's PennEnviroScreen mapping tool:
<https://gis.dep.pa.gov/PennEnviroScreen/>
2. Put the location of the community in the search tool in the upper lefthand corner of the map. Ex: Norristown, PA



3. The mapping tool will zoom to the location entered in the search tool.



- From this view, click on a colored polygon to pull up the Tract Info. In this example, the red dot indicates which polygon was clicked, and the Tract Info appears on the lefthand side.



- Under Tract Info, look at the “Final Score Percentile.” For RISE PA, communities that have one or more tracts with a Final Score Percentile of 80th or above will be considered LIDACs for the purposes of the Community Benefits Bonus. In this example, Norristown would therefore meet that requirement and be an eligible target area.
