SCOPE

PASSENGER VEHICLE CHARGING

- Interstate/Regional Travel on Interstate Routes
- Destination Trips (urban and rural)
- Emergency Travel
- Commuter Travel (including appropriate location for mobility hubs to encourage multimodal travel)

MEDIUM/HEAVY DUTY FREIGHT CHARGING

- Interstate/Regional Travel on interstate routes
- Rural Deliveries (is charging limiting services?)
- Emergency Travel (consider MD & NY evacuation to PA)



SCOPE

PASSENGER VEHICLE CHARGING

- Interstate/Regional Travel on Interstate Routes
- Destination Trips (urban and rural)
- Emergency Travel
 - Top 10 possible emergencies according to PEMA:
 - 1. Floods
 - 2. Fires
 - 3. Winter storms
 - 4. Tropical storms, tornadoes, and thunderstorms
 - 5. Earthquakes and landslides
 - 6. Hazardous material incidents
 - 7. Pandemics
 - 8. Nuclear threats
 - 9. Dam and water threats
 - 10. Mass violence

REFINEMENT

PASSENGER VEHICLE CHARGING

- Equity/mobility in all goals/priorities
 - Safe/efficient intercity travel: charging every 50 miles within 1 mile of interstate and interstate look-alikes (consider quantity, FHWA alternative fuel corridor is within 5 miles).
 - Support destination trips (rural & urban): charging at key origins and destinations (multi-modal)
 - Use case: public state facilities, park & rides, entertainment venues, others
 - Safe evacuation in an emergency: determine location and number of chargers needed to address evacuation across state boundaries (ability to scale)
 - Use Case: Eastern PA

SCOPE

PASSENGER VEHICLE CHARGING

 Commuter Travel (including appropriate location for mobility hubs to encourage multimodal travel)

PATH FORWARD

PASSENGER VEHICLE CHARGING

 Commuter Travel: Determine framework for addressing commuter travel (mobility hubs, partners for workplace charging, MUD charging, etc., public buildings)

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MEDIUM/HEAVY DUTY FREIGHT CHARGING

- Safe/efficient intercity travel: identify 100+ mile charging gaps between truck stops
- Rural Deliveries: Identify how best to support fleets as they convert to EV (they will likely want their own charging).
 Permitting.
- Safe evacuation in an emergency: Determine framework for identifying chargers needed to evacuate – including across state boundaries.
