## COMBUSTIBLE MATERIALS AND ROCK DUSTING

§ 208.71. Maintenance of incombustible content of rock dust.

(a) <u>Where rock dust is required to be applied, it must be distributed upon the</u> top, floor, and sides of all underground areas of a coal mine and maintained in such quantities that the incombustible content of the combined coal dust, rock dust, and other dust must be not less than 80 percent.

(b) <u>Where methane is present in any ventilating current, the percent of</u> incombustible content of such combined dust as required under subsection (a) must be increased 0.4 percent for each 0.1 percent of methane.

(c) <u>Moisture contained in the combined coal dust, rock dust and other dusts</u> <u>must be considered as a part of the incombustible content of such mixture.</u>
