



Project Location Help

The Area of Potential Effects (APE) consists of the geographic area or areas within which a project may directly or indirectly cause changes in the character or use of historic properties. The APE should include the project's physical boundaries as well as potential visual, vibrational, and/or audible effects to above ground resources. The Limit of Disturbance (LOD) is the area of total earth disturbance for the project. This includes all ancillary facilities such as access roads, utilities, material borrow areas, and staging areas.

You can either draw the APE and LOD on the map or upload as a Shapefile. If the LOD field is required on your map, you can toggle between editing the APE and LOD by clicking the appropriate button. The LOD **must** be fully contained within the APE as it is a subset of the APE's geographic area. If the LOD field is not present on the map widgets, your submission does not require an LOD.

The APE for building rehabilitation should be drawn as the boundary of the current tax parcel unless there is the potential for a visual effect on surrounding properties.
