The Department has completed its investigation concerning your October 15, 2008, complaint that your water supply had been affected by gas well drilling activities at the Armstrong Gas Company, LLC, [REDACTED] gas well (DEP Permit No. [REDACTED]), and we have determined that your water supply had been affected by the aforementioned site.

Our determination was based on information gathered from site inspections, documented timelines, gas and water well records, area geology and our sample results.

As you are obviously aware, Armstrong Gas Company, LLC had initially supplied you with a temporary water supply and subsequently drilled your well deeper as a replacement well. Samples taken at your residence on January 6, 2009, and February 4, 2009, from the deepened well is comparable to a pre-drill sample taken on August 6, 2008.
