Dear

This letter is regarding your water supply listed in Exhibit A as Water Supply D. On August 22, 2022, the Department received your complaint requesting an investigation of your water supply listed in Exhibit A as Water Supply A. Investigation of the initial water supply resulted in the sampling of additional water supplies listed in Exhibit A as Water Supplies B, C, and D. Based on the water sample results and other information obtained to date, the Department has determined that your water supply identified as Water Supply D in Exhibit A has been impacted by oil and gas activities. Furthermore, the Department has determined that your Water Supplies listed in Exhibit A as Water Supplies A, B, and C may have been impacted by oil and gas activities too.

Please find enclosed the Department's Notice to Greylock Energy ("Notice"). As you can see, the Notice requests that certain actions take place within defined timeframes. While it is your prerogative as to whether to continue to use any of these water supplies, you may consider not using Water Supply D until the corrective actions listed in the Notice have been addressed, and you may consider not utilizing Water Supplies A, B, and C until the quality of that water is analyzed as to whether it is suitable for your animals. In that regard, the Department offers to refer your complaint to the PA Department of Agriculture's Bureau of Animal Health and Diagnostic Services. Please let us know if you request that referral. In any event, the Department will continue to pursue this matter.
