Policy Revision Overview

- Policies first developed in the 1990s
- Purposes of 2017 Updates:
 - Increase clarity in wording
 - Modernize where outdated
 - Remove non-substantive information (DEP's internal workflow processes)
 - Initiate meaningful conversation between DEP and all stakeholders on our policy development



Regulatory Review Policy

Title: Development and Review of Regulations

Policy Number: 012-0820-001

Background:

- Originally developed in 1996.
- Last updated in 1999.



Regulatory Review Policy

Provides an overview of:

- DEP's unique regulatory review process
- Role and procedure for comments received during the public participation phase
- Interactions between DEP and other Commonwealth agencies, departmental advisory committees, boards and councils



Regulatory Review Policy

Summary of Revisions:

- Updates made to ensure that the policy remains relevant to current practice
- Explains how amendments made to the Regulatory Review Act in 2012 (Act 76) impact the way DEP carries out its regulatory process
- Policy was reformatted for clarity and readability



Technical Guidance Policy

Title: Policy for the Development and Publication of Technical Guidance

Policy Number: 012-0900-001

Background:

- Originally developed in 1996.
- Revised and published as Interim-Final in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* in May 2015.



Technical Guidance Policy

Provides an overview of:

- Purpose and role of TGDs
- Public comment periods and other tools for transparency
- Maintenance and distribution of TGDs



Technical Guidance Policy

Summary of Revisions:

- Significantly simplified from the previous version, removing non-substantive internal procedures
- Clarifications of the public comment process



Advisory Committee Policy

Title: Advisory Committee Guidelines

Policy Number: 012-1920-002

Background:

- Originally published May 5, 1998.
- No update after 1998.



Advisory Committee Policy

Provides an overview of:

 The role, function, and expectations of DEP's advisory committees. DEP currently works with over 25 advisory committees including the Citizen's Advisory Council.



Advisory Committee Policy

Summary of Revisions:

- Clarifies the roles of advisory committee members, the public, and DEP related to the planning and holding of advisory committee meetings.
- Clarifies role of advisory committees and members in the regulatory review and technical guidance review processes.
