The Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) has reviewed the above referenced application package and has determined that it is incomplete. The following list specifies the items missing from the submission which must be included in the resubmittal of your application and/or the submission of additional information.

Please note that this information must be <u>received in triplicate</u> within sixty (60) calendar days from the date of this letter, on or before May 21, 2019, or DEP will consider the application withdrawn.

Items Missing from Submission

- 1. Provide a GIF Form which is signed. [Joint Permit Application Instructions]
- 2. The application fee provided is only for the disturbed acres portion of the fee and does not include the \$500 fee for the Major Amendment Application. Provide a revised fee calculation worksheet and the additional necessary application fee. [Joint Permit Application Instructions, 105.13(c)(2)]
- 3. Provide a map showing the location and orientation of the color photographs.][Joint Permit Application Instructions, 105.13(e)(1)(iv)]
- 4. Provide proof of receipt of the cultural resource notice to PHMC and a review letter from PHMC. [Joint Permit Application Instructions]
- 5. Provide proof of submission to the Perry County Conservation District for the E&S Plan. [25 Pa Code 105.13(g)]
- 6. Provide an engineer seal and certification with the application. [25 Pa Code 105.13(j)]

You may request a time extension, in writing, before May 21, 2019 to respond to the deficiencies beyond the sixty (60) calendar days. Requests for time extensions will be reviewed by DEP and considered. You will be notified in writing of the decision either to grant or deny, including a specific due date to respond if the extension is granted. Time extensions shall be in accordance with 25 Pa. Code § 105.13a(b).

DEP has developed a standardized review process and processing times for all permits or other authorizations that it issues or grants. Pursuant to its Permit Review Process and Permit Decision Guarantee Policy (021-2100-001), DEP guarantees to provide permit decisions within the published time frames, provided applicants submit complete, technically adequate applications that address all applicable regulatory and statutory requirements, in the first submission. Since you did not submit a complete and/or technically adequate application, DEP's Permit Decision Guarantee is no longer applicable to your application.

As stipulated in 25 Pa. Code § 105.13a of DEP's Chapter 105 Rules and Regulations (regarding Complete applications) information requested by this office must be received in triplicate within sixty (60) calendar days from the date of this letter, on or before May 21, 2019, or DEP will consider the application to be withdrawn by the applicant and no further action will be taken on the application. Fees are not refunded when an application is considered to be withdrawn.
