The Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) has reviewed the permit modification request submitted on March 1, 2018, for Permit No. E15-862. This request is specific to the East Swedesford Road HDD S3-0381 location in West Whiteland Township, Chester County. The requested permit modification involves a change from a single long HDD installation to a combination of open trench installation, five conventional auger bore installations, and one FlexBor installation.


After review of this modification request, DEP has determined that this request proposes no additional permanent impacts to Chapter 105 regulated resources, and additional temporary impacts are limited to the overbank floodway.

Please be advised that your request has been approved, and the Chapter 105 Permit No. E15-862 is amended to include the revised activities. Also, be advised that trenchless construction methodologies are subject to the HDD Inadvertent Return Assessment, Preparedness, Prevention, and Contingency Plan (revised April 16, 2018). This document (Section 2.0) applies to all trenchless construction methodologies that use fluids under pressure, including HDD, guided auger bores, cradle bores, conventional auger bores, jack bore/hammer bores, guided bores, and FlexBors. Accordingly, you must comply with its terms, which include providing certain notifications to DEP and nearby landowners (Section 6.5), and offering water well testing to landowners with a private water supply located within 450 feet of the HDD (Section 6.6), as applicable.

All conditions specified in the original permit and plans remain in effect and are to be complied with as part of this permit revision. Please ensure that the plans are fully implemented and available at the construction site.
