Dear Carolyn:

I am in receipt of a November 10, 2015 letter from Tetra Tech acting on behalf of Sunoco Pipeline LP. The document describes the intent of this company to install an approximately 300 mile-long gas pipeline between an area south of Pittsburgh to Marcus Hook in Delaware County Pennsylvania. The path of the pipeline will traverse New Morgan Borough.

The letter is more specific in that it requests an acknowledgment from our Borough that the pipeline does not violate either our stormwater management regulations or our floodplain regulations. Based upon the description of work in the letter and the exhibits provided, the assumption is made that all permanent impacts will be limited to underground utilities and no aboveground facilities are to be located in New Morgan Borough. Further, it does not appear that any linear encroachment of the floodplain is anticipated with the work. Therefore, I can suggest that the project will be in compliance with our rules and regulations.

However, I should also point out that the contractor will need to secure certain grading permits from the Borough which will memorialize all state and federal permits for erosion control measures, site access, stabilization, and any restrictions placed upon access prior to start of construction.
