Project type, purpose and need: Installation of two parallel natural gas liquid pipelines within an approximately 306.8-mile, 50foot-wide right-of-way (ROW) from Houston, Washington County, Pennsylvania to Sunoco Pipeline L.P.'s (SPLP's) Marcus Hook facility in Delaware County, Pennsylvania with the purpose of interconnecting with existing SPLP Mariner East pipelines. A 20-inch diameter pipeline would be installed within the ROW from Houston to Marcus Hook (306.8 miles) and a

second, 16-inch diameter pipeline, would also be installed in the same ROW from SPLP's Delmont Station in Westmoreland County to the Marcus Hook facility (for approximately 255.8 miles). Please refer to Attachment 9 for a more detailed Project Description.


