Reference: Sunoco Pipeline L.P. – Pennsylvania Pipeline Project Stormwater Management Program Consistency Request

Dear Commissioners:

On behalf of Sunoco Pipeline, L.P. (SPLP), Tetra Tech is in the process of providing data to the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (PADEP), to obtain a Chapter 105 Water Obstruction and Encroachment Permit for the Pennsylvania Pipeline Project (Project). The Project involves the installation of approximately two parallel pipelines within a 306-mile, 50-foot-wide right-of-way (ROW) from Houston, Washington County, Pennsylvania to SPLP's Marcus Hook facility in Delaware County, Pennsylvania with the purpose of interconnecting with existing SPLP Mariner East pipelines. A 20-inch diameter pipeline would be installed within the ROW from Houston to Marcus Hook (306 miles) and a second, up to 20-inch diameter pipeline, will also be installed in the same ROW from SPLP's Delmont Station, Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania to the Marcus Hook facility, paralleling the initial line for approximately 255 miles. Additional aboveground facilities, such as block valves and pump stations will be required to complete the project. The project will require crossing various streams and wetlands in the project area, including direct temporary disturbances to streams and wetlands at installation locations. Once pipeline installation has been completed, trenches will be backfilled with the excavated material, and water/wetland resources will be restored to preconstruction contours and stabilized with native vegetation. Only at aboveground facilities will change in grades occur, with the majority of these facilities located outside of floodways and 100-year floodplains. Overall, the Project will be designed, constructed, and operated in compliance with all applicable provisions of 25 Pennsylvania Code, Chapter 102 Regulations (Erosion and Sediment Control and Post Construction Stormwater Management Best Management Practices including the implementation of Antidegradation Best Available Combination of Technologies (ABACT methods) where applicable, to maintain the designated use of receiving waters in the area and no increase in stormwater runoff, rate or volume would occur.

As part of the permit approval process, we and Sunoco respectfully request your review and a letter confirming the Project's consistency with the County or the local municipality's Storm Water Management program (as applicable). A consistency letter from the County or municipality in regard to the local Storm Water Management Program is required pursuant to the Stormwater Management Act (32 P.S.,§§ 680.1—680.17). The Project crosses several municipalities in Chester County, including Elverson Borough, and West Nantmeal, East Nantmeal, Wallace, Upper Uwchlan, Uwchlan, West Whiteland, East Whiteland, West Goshen, East Goshen, and Westtown Townships. We have received consistency determinations from Elverson Borough and Westtown Township; however we have not received consistency determinations from West Nantmeal, East Nantmeal, Wallace, Upper Uwchlan, Uwchlan, West Whiteland, East Whiteland, West Goshen, and East Goshen Townships at this time. 


