Dear Ms. Barkasi:

Per your request, attached is an application for a Stormwater Management Permit for the Pennsylvania Pipeline Project within West Nantmeal Township. The project was designed to meet the requirements of the County-Wide Act 167 Stormwater Management Plan for Chester County, PA and Chapter 102 regulations. In general, the pre-construction drainage patterns surrounding the project will be maintained, and all disturbed areas within the pipeline ROW will be restored to a meadow in good condition, with the exception of proposed permanent features, existing permanent features within the right of way, and lawn in residential areas where the landowner has required that lawn cover be reestablished. As a result of restoring the ROW to a meadow condition or lawn, the project will not result in increased stormwater runoff rate or volume for the pipeline corridor. There are no permanent stormwater BMPs or impervious areas proposed within West Nantmeal Township. Sunoco Pipeline LP ("SPLP") will reimburse the township for the cost associated with the review.

As a public utility corporation certificated and regulated by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, SPLP's nonbuilding facilities, including the pipeline, are not subject to municipal zoning, and Subdivision/Land Development regulations. See <u>Duquesne Light Co. v. Upper St. Clair Twp.</u>, 105 A.2d 287 (Pa. 1954). SP LP files this application under protest and reserves all rights afforded to it as a public utility corporation.
