We have reviewed the Updated Project Workspaces submitted by Tetra Tech on November 2, 2016 for the above-referenced project. The Township has previously stated in a letter dated December 3, 2015 that the proposed activity was consistent with the Township Stormwater Management Ordinance.

The newly-identified workspaces proposed for the project are temporary for use during construction and are located within the previously-established ROW. No permanent structures or access roads are proposed in the FEMA-designated floodways or 100-year floodplain areas. Therefore, the updated project workspaces do not affect the Township's previous consistency determination. However, please be advised that the Township expects that all temporary roads/use areas will be restored to their existing conditions upon completion of the project.
