Per your request, attached is the Grading/Stormwater Management Permit application, Erosion and Sediment Control Plan, Site Restoration and Post-Construction Stormwater Management Plan, and review fee (\$250.00) for the Pennsylvania Pipeline Project within Edgmont Township. The construction and restoration practices for the proposed pipeline have been designed to meet the provisions of the PADEP Chapter 102 regulations. Preconstruction drainage patterns surrounding the project will be maintained. Because the disturbed areas will be restored to a meadow condition, the project will not result in increased stormwater runoff rate or volume. Therefore, no permanent stormwater BMPs or impervious areas are proposed within Edgmont Township.

As a public utility corporation certificated and regulated by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, Sunoco Pipeline LP's ("SPLP") nonbuilding facilities, including the pipeline, do not require formal zoning or subdivision/land development approval and are not subject to regulation by local municipalities for the design, location, or construction of facilities. See Duquesne Light Co. v. Upper St. Clair Twp., 105 A.2d 287 (Pa. 1954). SPLP files this application under protest and reserves all rights afforded to it as a public utility corporation.
