The Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) reviewed Sunoco Logistics L.P.'s (SPLP) Horizontal Directional Drill (HDD) Reevaluation Report submitted on December 12, 2018. The HDD Reevaluation Report was posted on the DEP Mariner East II pipeline portal webpage on December 13, 2018. SPLP submitted supplemental information on January 14, 2019 in response to a request by DEP, which was posted on the DEP Mariner East II pipeline portal webpage on January 16, 2019.

DEP also received and reviewed public comments on the HDD Re-evaluation Report submitted jointly by Clean Air Council, Mountain Watershed Association, and Delaware Riverkeeper Network. In response to those comments, DEP undertook further evaluation and concluded that the concerns raised were adequately addressed.

As part of the HDD Reevaluation Report, SPLP has proposed a redesign of the profile to go deeper into competent bedrock. The deepening of the profile results in a lengthening of the HDD which results in relocation of the entry/exit pit outside of the permitted limit of disturbance. This proposed revision requires a permit modification which must be approved by DEP's Southwest Regional Office in writing prior to the relocation of the entry/exit pit outside of the permitted limit of disturbance. Upon approval of the required permit modification, SPLP may proceed with the permitted activity in the manner proposed in SPLP's HDD Reevaluation Report submitted December 12, 2018, and in accordance with all applicable permit terms and conditions.
