The Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) has reviewed the supplemental Horizontal Directional Drilling (HDD) analysis submitted for S3-0370, E15-862, for the installation of a 16-inch and 20-inch diameter pipeline under North Pottstown Pike and streams S-C59, S-C60, and S-C61 in West Whiteland Township, Chester County. This information was posted on DEP's Mariner East II pipeline portal webpage on November 8, 2017, and December 20, 2017. DEP received responses from Sunoco Pipeline, L.P. (SPLP), to our December 6, 2017, comment letter on December 20, 2017.

According to the conclusions in your Re-Evaluation Report, SPLP proposes to abandon the originally proposed HDD design and instead pursue a combination of open trench (in uplands) and four conventional bores. As HDD is no longer proposed, the related concerns with HDD are now moot and the supplemental information is deemed adequate.

You are reminded that the proposed changes in methodology require both Chapters 102 and 105 permit modifications. The Chapter 102 (E&S Permit) modification has been received and is under review; however, DEP has not yet received a Chapter 105 permit modification for the temporary bridges and floodway impacts described in your Open-cut analysis.
