Dear Commissioners:

This municipal notice, under the requirements of Acts 14, 67, 68, and 127, is to inform you that our client, Sunoco Pipeline, L.P. (SPLP), intends to apply for a Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (PADEP) Chapter 105 Water Obstruction and Encroachment permit application for the following proposed project:

Project Name: Pennsylvania Pipeline Project (“Project”)

Applicant Name: Sunoco Pipeline, L.P.

Project Description: The Project involves the installation of approximately two parallel pipelines within a 306-mile, 50-foot-wide right-of-way (ROW) from Houston, Washington County, Pennsylvania to SPLP’s Marcus Hook facility in Delaware County, Pennsylvania with the purpose of interconnecting with existing SPLP Mariner East pipelines. A 20-inch diameter pipeline would be installed within the ROW from Houston to Marcus Hook (306 miles) and a second, up to 20-inch diameter pipeline, will also be installed in the same ROW. The second line is proposed to be installed from SPLP’s Delmont Station, Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania to the Marcus Hook facility, paralleling the initial line for approximately 255 miles. This project will require crossing various streams and wetlands in the project area, including direct temporary disturbances to streams and wetlands at installation locations. Once installation has been completed, trenches will be backfilled with the excavated material, and water/wetland resources will be restored to preconstruction contours and stabilized with native vegetation. Erosion and sedimentation control best management practices will be used during all phases of construction.




