**COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA
PENNSYLVANIA FISH AND BOAT COMMISSION**

**SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT FOR DISTURBANCE OF WATERWAYS AND
WATERSHEDS AND/OR POLLUTION OF WATERS**

On this 14th day of November 2014, the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Pennsylvania Fish and Boat Commission (“COMMISSION”) and Sunoco Logistics Partners L.P. (“RESPONSIBLE PARTY”), enter into this Agreement as follows:

WHEREAS, the COMMISSION alleges that the RESPONSIBLE PARTY has committed an act or acts of disturbance of waterways and watersheds and/or pollution of waters, as described in this Agreement, under Section 2502 and/or Section 2504 of the Fish and Boat Code, 30 Pa. C.S. §§ 2502 and/or 2504, and/or is liable for civil damages under Section 2506 of the Fish and Boat Code, 30 Pa. C.S. § 2506; and

WHEREAS, the RESPONSIBLE PARTY is willing to voluntarily waive his/her/its right to trial before a court of competent jurisdiction to determine guilt and/or civil liability and settle the alleged violations detailed in this Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the COMMISSION is willing to settle the charges against the RESPONSIBLE PARTY and to forego prosecution and/or civil action for damages in accordance with the terms of this Agreement, and the RESPONSIBLE PARTY desires to enter this Agreement;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the following mutual promises and covenants, the parties desiring to be legally bound, hereby covenant and agree as follows:

1. The RESPONSIBLE PARTY voluntarily agrees to pay the COMMISSION the sum of Three Thousand Five Hundred DOLLARS (\$3,500.00) in lieu of fines and civil damages in full and complete settlement of the violations of the Fish and Boat Code alleged in Paragraph 3.

2. The COMMISSION agrees to accept payment and, upon satisfactory deposit of the settlement amount, agrees not to institute or pursue criminal prosecution or civil action for damages resulting from the violations alleged in Paragraph 3.

3. The following violations are alleged by the COMMISSION and are subject to this Agreement:

On September 18, 2014 drilling operations under SR88 caused an Inadvertent Return to Surface of bentonite to flow into Flomans Run at Mingo Church Road.

On September 19, 2014 drilling operations under SR88 caused another IRTS to occur and flow into and UNT to Flomans Run at Patterson Road.

4. The RESPONSIBLE PARTY agrees to render payment of good money and agrees that if payment is not valid for any reason, the COMMISSION shall reinstitute or commence prosecution and/or civil action for the violations alleged in Paragraph 3 and the statute of limitations for filing any such action or prosecution shall be tolled due to the delay caused by the invalid payment.

5. This Agreement is limited to prosecutions and civil actions brought by the COMMISSION for alleged violations of the Fish and Boat Code and does not otherwise affect any prosecutions or civil actions instituted by third parties or other agencies of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania under any other law, including but not limited to the Clean Streams Law, Act of June 22, 1937, P.L. 1987, No. 394, as amended, 35 P.S. § 691.1 et seq.

6. This Agreement shall be construed under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

7. By signing this Agreement, the RESPONSIBLE PARTY acknowledges that he/she/it has read this Agreement, agrees to its terms and conditions, without any admission of liability under the Fish and Boat Code or otherwise, and acknowledges that he/she/it is WAIVING AND FORFEITING HIS/HER/ITS RIGHTS TO A TRIAL BEFORE A COURT TO DETERMINE GUILT, INNOCENCE AND/OR CIVIL LIABILITY.

8. Any additional conditions shall be listed as follows:

Sunoco Logistics agrees to donate \$1000.00 to the Washington County Parks Board to be used for habitat improvement in the Mingo Creek watershed.
